CLASS SPECIFICATIONS:

Jumper Classes

Speed Class: This format challenges the rider to go fast and clear to get a good ribbon. This type of format is known to exhibitors as a speed round. There is no jump off, meaning that the rider must go fast in the first round to improve the chances of winning. Faults have the same effect in this round, so people with rails place below people with no faults, even if their time is better.

Jump Off Class: In this format. all riders and horse combinations compete in the first round of the class. If the horse has no jumping or time faults in the first round they will stay in the ring for the jump-off portion. The jump-off is a shorter version of first round, and the rider with the fastest time and least amount of faults wins the class.

Equitation Classes

“Equitation is the art or practice of horse riding or horsemanship. More specifically, equitation may refer to a rider’s position while mounted, and encompasses a rider’s ability to ride correctly and with effective aids. In horse show competition, the rider, rather than the horse is evaluated”.

Beginner Equitation Class: This format is for riders who are in the early stages of riding; they should be capable of mastering control, stabilization, relaxation, independence, feel and finesse. Competitors are eligible to enter only WT and/or WTC if they would like.

Knox 2” Equitation Class: This format is open to all competitors who can perform 2” jumping courses that will consist of six to eight jumps and flat. Flat class will consist of Walk, Trot, Canter. It will be up to the judge’s discretion to ask for sitting trot, two point, no stirrups and/or canter without stirrups.

Pre Mini Class: This format is open to all junior competitors who can perform a 2”6 jumping course and also a “test”. The “test” will be asked of the rider in their second jumping course. It will be up to the judge’s discretion to ask for sitting trot, two point, no stirrups and/or canter without stirrups.

Hunter Classes

“Hunt seat competition in North America includes both flat and over fences for show hunters, which judge the horse’s movement and form”.

Knox 2” HUNTER: This format will be offered as a division with multiple over fences classes and an under saddle. Open to all competitors who are able to jump 2” on a regular basis.

Knox 2”6 HUNTER: This format will be offered as a division with multiple over fences classes and an under saddle. Open to all competitors who are able to jump 2”6 on a regular basis.

Rules and Regulations

1. Every class which is offered herein will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the United States Equestrian Federation.
2. Schooling shows are not eligible for USEF points. They are a day of unrecognized competitions for the benefit of all competitors.
3. ENTRIES: Entries will be taken by phone or e-mail until **September 28, 2019**.
4. Mailed entries, regular or e-mailed, are the responsibility of the entrant & must be received by the above deadline. No one will be permitted to perform without payment of all fees. All exhibitors must sign a release form & a parent/guardian's signature is required for all Junior riders.
5. Refunds will only be available upon receipt of a veterinarian certificate
6. Schooling for all Jumper classes will be from 7:00 to 8:00 a.m.
7. Schooling for all Equitation classes will be 15 minutes in-between each class.
8. Schooling for all Hunter classes will be 15 minutes in-between each class.
9. No entry will be accepted unless signed by the rider, owner/agent and coach/trainer and the required fees in negotiable funds accompany a completed entry blank.
10. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide or move any class. Classes with less than 3 entries may be combined or cancelled.
11. Martingales are not permitted in any flat classes.
12. Flashes will not be permitted in equitation or hunters.
13. Boots, bandages or wraps are not permitted in hunter divisions.
14. Dogs will not be permitted on the property for any reason.
15. The Knox School and their management officials and employees shall not be liable for any injury to a person or property of any exhibitor, rider, spectator, visitor, groom or any other person by reason of any event occurring during the course of the shows.
16. A fee of \$15.00 plus collection fees will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
17. Main Ring- sand/fiber all weather footing 250'x150'
18. Entries will be taken by mail or email. Post entries are available with an additional fee of \$25.00 per rider.

RIDER'S RELEASE AGREEMENT

I acknowledge that I or my child will engage in horseback riding and other equestrian activities operated by The Knox School and "the facility". I represent that I am experienced in horsemanship or it has been explained to me that equestrian activities can be dangerous and I hereby accept and assume all risks to my person or that of my child and to my personal property while engaging in such activities. I for myself or my child, understand that the wearing of a properly fitted and SEI certified equestrian helmet while riding or near horses may reduce the severity of some of the wearer's head injuries and possibly prevent the wearer's death from happenings as the result of fall or other occurrences. As such, I agree for myself or for my child that an ATSM certified helmet will be worn while riding on the premises known as The Knox School. I hereby waive, release and relinquish all rights and claims I may now or hereafter have against The Knox School and the County of Suffolk, NY, the owners of the land and buildings, upon which it operates their business, their servants, agents, officers, employees with respect to any or all injury to myself, my child, my horse and damage to my personal property which may arise, directly, or indirectly, at the said premises while visiting or participating in any activities. This waiver and release shall bind me, my heirs and legal representatives. By signing this release, if applicable, I am consenting to have my minor child show in this event.

CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION AWARDS:

In equestrian competitions, The rider is scored on each individual showing on a scale of 1-6. All the scores for each rider are averaged and the highest is the Grand Champion; the second highest is the Reserve Champion. Grand Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be handed out at the end of every class.
