The Cold War: 1945 - 1991

The second half of the 20th century was shaped by the Cold War, a legacy of World War II. The United States and the Soviet Union emerged as global superpowers engaged in ideological, political, economic, and military competition.

Essential Question:

How do cooperation and competition between nations impact the international community and the lives of individuals in the countries involved?

Assignment: Use scholarly research to create a digital timeline about The Cold War: 1945-1991

Guidelines:

- 3. Each event should be summarized with at least one paragraph describing the context, cause and effect, and significance of the event.
