

THE VISUAL DIARY-Due Date: Mon. Jan. 11, 2021

Over the Winter Break photograph taking two rolls of film comprising the events of your break.

You may interpret this assignment in a few ways. You can take your camera with you one day and photograph the events of your day from start to finish so that each image works with the other in more of a narrative sense.....telling a story with pictures.

You may also broaden the diary to where you simply are photographing either an event or some of the highlights of your vacation.

Think of visual opportunities. Are you going away for the holiday? Maybe you want to photograph everyone opening their presents on Christmas morning. Will you visit family or friends?

This project can also work as a photo essay...think of all the steps to make a holiday dinner....you can photograph the step by step process. Do you have a special family tradition that perhaps you would like to show?

You will have more time to go to different locations to shoot or have more opportunities to make pictures. The idea is as important as the pictures, so always be thinking in your head....what will make a good photograph visually? Bring your camera with you as much as possible, so when sometimes that great photograph happens, you are there to capture the moment.

Try to shoot outdoors...so you will not have movement in your photograph or use a tripod or light stand from school. If you shoot indoors, remember you shouldn't be shooting less than 1/30th sec, so you should have good light. Remember if you are shooting outdoors on a cold day to keep the camera close to you to keep it warm. Think about light/time of day and remember it starts getting dark at 4:30pm.

Reload your camera and shoot a second roll.

Don't wait until January 10th to shoot these rolls, otherwise it will not realistically be a representation of your vacation and will also look rushed.
